4 以下の英文を読み、各設問に答えなさい。

Have you ever wondered where Apple's iPhone is made? Apple's *headquarters is located in California, where iPhone models are designed by a talented team of engineers and designers. So you might assume that the iPhone is made by workers in the United States. However, (1) the answer to the question is more complex than you may expect.

To answer the question, we need to understand the difference between manufacturing and *assembly. Manufacturing is the process of making the parts that go into the iPhone. (A) Apple designs and sells the iPhone, it doesn't manufacture its individual parts. Instead, the company uses manufacturers from around the world to supply these. And there are hundreds of parts—including wires, batteries, and chips. In total, Apple works with more than 200 different suppliers in over 40 countries. Among the top supplier nations are China, the United States, Japan, and South Korea.

Assembly is the process of taking all those individual parts and combining them into a finished, working iPhone. (2) The assembly of iPhones takes place in China, which has shown itself to be good at meeting demand quickly. In 2007, for example, just a few weeks before the first iPhone was released, Apple co-founder Steve Jobs decided to (B) the iPhone's plastic screen with a glass screen. This new glass screen would be *scratch-proof. American companies said this was impossible—they would need several months to create new production lines to make the change. A Chinese factory, however, accepted the work and proved it was possible.

"People just look at where the final product is assembled," says Apple CEO, Tim Cook. According to Cook, (3) we need to look at the bigger picture. In a global world, he says, manufacturing needs to be done in a variety of countries, so it's not easy to say exactly where a product is made. Thus, making an iPhone is truly a worldwide effort.
